## David J. Peterkin Symphonic Band

**July 29 – August 11**

This camp is recommended if you are in Grade 11 or 12 with at least three years of experience on your instrument. Included are full band rehearsals, small ensembles, private lessons, practice time, musicianship classes as well as faculty and student performances.



## Francis E. Dunnigan Concert Band

**July 29 – August 4**

An incredible camp intended for musicians in grades 8 through 10 with at least two years of experience on your instrument. Included are full band rehearsals, small ensembles, private lessons, practice time, musicianship classes as well as faculty and student performances.



## Jazz Band Workshop

**August 5 – 11**

Dive into the world of jazz music and refine your skills in improvisation, listening, style, phrasing, charts, chord reading and soloing. This workshop is perfect for if you have little or no jazz experience or if you are an advanced player interested in building more skills.



## Musical Theatre Intensive + Performance

**August 5 – 18**

Take your musical theatre experience to the next level! Participate in two weeks of skill building classes with personalized coaching in acting, voice and dance. In week two you will put your skills to work producing and performing popular musical repertoire! Recommended if you are in Grades 9 through 12.

**Note:** Mature students interested in participating in this camp who do not meet the grade recommendation are encouraged to contact the camp director before registering.



## Musical Theatre Performance

**August 12 – 18**

Become the next triple threat as you learn vocal technique, performance ability and choreography – all while taking part in the production and performance of popular musical repertoire. Recommended if you are in Grades 7 through 12 with any level of experience.

## Cancellations & Refunds

Full refunds are available if the School of Continuing Education cancels a course. If you must withdraw from a course, simply notify us at least 30 days before the course begins and we will attempt to accommodate you into another course or issue you a refund, less a \$100 cancellation fee. Registrations cancelled less than 30 days before the course start date will not be eligible for a refund. A \$25 fee is charged for all NSF cheques.
